Mollyguajeck Falls 2015 project:

- ✓ There are two items Outstanding: - the \$16,000.00 funding from section 79.2 of the finds division and the \$5,000.00 DFO allocation to construct the fish way trap.
- ✓ The DFO license application to operate the fish way trap is completed.
- ✓ The application for an ATV trail designation from the old Terra Nova forestry road to Mollyguajeck Falls is completed.
- ✓ The Crown Lands Division is looking for FABEC to register the two camps at Mollyguajeck Falls.
- ✓ Modernizations plans are being finalized for the two camps at Mollyguajeck Falls.
- ✓ The first funding installment from ASCF was received May 27, 2015.

Service Canada student summer employment 2015:

There are a total of 5 student positions approved for summer employment with FABEC in 2015. All positions are classed as river monitors/creel surveyors and 2 will be assigned to the upper Terra Nova River, 2 will be assigned to Maccles Brook and 1 will be assigned to Middle Brook. The positions are for seven week duration.

Additionally, Service Canada has approved two student positions for employment with the Development Association for 2015. Both positions will be assigned as student assistants at the fish way on Middle Brook and the Terra Nova River at Grant Falls.

Ministerial Advisory Committee on Atlantic salmon:

In April 2015 Kevin Stroud and John Baird represented FABEC and presented a position paper to the Ministerial Advisory Committee. To date we have not received any follow up from the Ministerial Advisory Committee or any indication on future recommendations to improve Atlantic salmon stocks in NL Rivers.

Terra Nova River salmon enhancement 1984 to 2001:

Atlantic salmon enhancement projects operated continuously beginning in 1984 through to 2001 on the Terra Nova River system. During each year the projects operated there was an annual report prepared for the project's sponsors. These annual reports contain valuable information and need to be preserved for future reference. Thus it is FABEC's desire to assemble all of the reports and permanently file on its web.

During the meeting Paul Stewart informed the group that he has made progress in updating FABEC's Web site and all monthly meetings are available for viewing on the web.

On May 3, 2015 Mr. Fred Holloway, the founding president of the Freshwater-Alexander Bays Ecosystem Corporation passed away. Fred was a long standing member of our watershed group and his presence will be missed.
