CBPP/Kruger- New 5 year Forestry Plan (2017-2021) for District 05:

Mr. Barry Elkins of Kruger presented a new 5 year (2017-2021) Forestry operating plan for District 05 which includes the Middle Brook Watershed. Mr. Elkins indicated the Pussel's Pond forestry cutting operations concluded at the end of February 2016 and trucking operations should end in the next 10 days. Once all harvested wood is removed the area will receive a final review and then temporary barriers will be placed pending reforestation operations and then permanent decommissioning of the road network will be completed per the agreed MOU between Kruger/FABEC.

The new forestry plan for district 05 will commence January 1, 2017 and cover 5 years expiring December 31, 2021. The area of interest to FABEC is the Butt's Pond region. Kruger is planning forestry operations on the North and West sides of Butt's Pond. The plan is to extend the existing Denty's Pitt Road with a new all season road into the timber stands and to use existing roads where applicable in the region of Butt's Pond. All logging operations in the Butt's pond area will be carried out during the winter period. There will be a 100 meter buffer zone in timber stands that boarder Butt's pond and timber will not be harvested in close proximity of cabin lots on Butt's Pond.

FABEC will draft an MOU to cover the proposed new 5 year logging plan in the Butt's Pond area and present to CBPP/Kruger for signing.

CBPP/Kruger- Public Advisory Committee:

FABEC has been invited to participate in Kruger's Public Advisory Committee meetings. The next meeting is 4:00 PM March 16, 2016 at the Glynmill Inn in Corner Brook. John Baird and Harvey Garrett will attend and advise FABEC members at its next regular meeting.

The only agency that has not responded to enquires on the MFF ATV trail is the Forestry Division in Clarenville .
