Meeting focus: Conservation - Zoning issues

- (1) To consider, approve or change the final draft of our "Conservation issues" letter. (see Minutes Meeting #1)

By consensus the "conservation issues" letter was approved with the exception that #2 issue - Terra Nova River - be changed from "Delay the opening of catch & retain fishing on the Terra Nova River until after July 14...."

TO THE FOLLOWING:

"Delay the opening of catch and retain fishing on the Terra Nova River until a portion of fish have passed through the lower fishway (Grant Falls)."

Chairman, Fred Holloway agreed to change the letter accordingly and fax to Wayne Fillet on October 23.

We felt mid November would be an appropriate time for DFO to hold meetings on these issues.

- (ii) Prepare for a meeting with council re: zoning issues. After consideration of the issues, John Baird agreed to draft a letter (see attached) describing the zones we request.
